## STATE OF MINNESOTA OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS

In the Matter of the Proposed Rules Governing Elevators and Related Devices, Minnesota Rules Chapter 1307 ORDER ON REVIEW OF RESUBMITTED RULES UNDER MINN. STAT. § 14.26, SUBD. 3 AND MINN. R. 1400.2300, SUBP. 8

This matter came on for review by the Chief Administrative Law Judge pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.26 (2020) and Minn. R. 1400.2300 (2019). The Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (Department) proposes to adopt the above-entitled rules pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.26.

On July 20, 2020, the Department filed all documents required under Minn. Stat. § 14.26 and Minn. R. 1400.2310 with the Office of Administrative Hearings. On August 6, 2020, Administrative Law Judge Eric L. Lipman issued an Order on Review of Rules. As set forth in that Order, the third sentence of proposed rule part 1307.0090, subp. 7(B) was disapproved. The Chief Administrative Law Judge concurred with the determination by an Order dated August 7, 2020.

The Department resubmitted the proposed rules on August 12, 2020, with modifications incorporating the changes recommended by Administrative Law Judge Lipman in his August 6, 2020, Order.

The Chief Administrative Law Judge finds that the defect identified in the prior order has been corrected. Based upon a review of the modifications made by the Department as presented in its August 12, 2020, submissions, and the rulemaking record,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The proposed rules, as modified and approved by the Revisor on August 7, 2020, are approved as to legality.
