LSS has established pathways and programs to increase access to career success with a focus on individuals with high barriers to success.

They assist with occupational skills training, on-the-job training, incumbent worker training, registered apprenticeships and much more. The program is funded by state and federal grants and is available at no cost to eligible participants who are eligible or receiving unemployment insurance benefits.
