

Work Comp Campus release notes 1.0.28 – Dec. 16, 2021

Insurers, self-insurers, third-party administrators and trading partners

1. Issue: Some external stakeholders reported being unable to submit an “Objection to Penalty” in Work Comp Campus.

Expected: Permissions have been updated to allow others, outside of just the designated penalty contact, to file the “Objection to Penalty” webform using the PN number.

Law firms

1. Issue: The affidavit of service with a “Motion to Intervene” incorrectly titles service recipients.

Expected: Titles are now listed correctly.

2. Issue: The “Substitution of Attorney” function was not operating properly.

Expected: The “Substitution of Attorney” function is now operating properly.

3. Issue: The legal team for an attorney was not being granted access to a dispute under a claim.

Expected: Access is now being granted to disputes when there is already access to the claim.

4. Issue: When creating a “Motion to Intervene,” duplicate dispute choices were offered on which to file the motion.

Expected: The dispute choices are now operating properly.

5. Issue: The “Request for Assistance” was not internally populating the “Disputed Issue” field, resulting in the external response function not operating properly.

Expected: The dispute is now properly populating internally, correcting the external response function.
